The finished pieces will form 'totems' to be installed adjacent to each of the five buildings in the St Marys Corner precinct.	\$9,236
A Kingswood Welcome	Small Shift	Kingswood	\$10,000	Supporting the Kingswood community to reimagine and create a welcoming gateway to Kingswood in public spaces around the Bringelly Rd and Orth St intersection. An ideation process with locals will develop quick and easy activation ideas before working together to implement these together e.g. book/toy share, chalk board, mural painting.	\$10,000
Skate Park Mural	NCNS: Nepean Community and Neighbourhood Sevices	Cranebrook	\$10,000	Workshops at the skate park for young people and the wider community will aim to empower residents in generating their own ideas for an artwork concept that will appear as a singular artwork from a distance and as a curated collection of individual expression when you look closer.	\$10,000
It's a Walk in the Park	NCNS: Nepean Community and Neighbourhood Sevices	Kingswood Park	\$9,300	Placemaking activities will both attract residents to a dull and lifeless park and revive the space through the creation of mosaic tiles for park games e.g. hopscotch and application of stencilled outlines from nature. Focus groups would be initiated alongside partnerships with outside services to develop the finished product.	\$9,300
