



Flood planning levels within the bounds of the Penrith Lakes Scheme are under consideration by the NSW State Government as a part of SEPP 1989. As a result, the Penrith Lakes Scheme area has been excluded from the Flood Planning Area map

The Flood Planning Area has been generally based on the 100 year ARI surface plus a freeboard of 0.5m.

The recommended FPL for the area of Emu Plains between the Great Western Highway and the railway has been based on the FPL along the southern edge of the highway (*refer to Section 10 in the report*).

This variation will remain as an interim measure until a Flood Risk Management Study and Plan is prepared and Council has adopted a suitable FPL for this area.
